



B. K. Afghan Memorial Award



**Commemorating the dedication of Dr.
Baderuddin Khan (Aff) Afghan to the Chemical Institute of
Canada and, in particular, to his service to the CIC
Environment Division and the CIC Hamilton Section**

- 1. PURPOSE** To recognize the involvement of Hamilton and Area Undergraduate students making a significant contribution to water analysis or treatment technology. The award includes \$500 honorarium and a Certificate.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY**
 - 2.1. Candidates must be either an undergraduate or within one year of graduating as an undergraduate student from a Chemical Programme, Mohawk College or from the Chemistry, Chemical Biology or Chemical Engineering Programmes, McMaster University.
 - 2.2. The work being submitted for consideration of this award should have been done while at one of these institutions while an undergraduate student and be no more than 1 year beyond graduation.
 - 2.3. Must be a member of the Chemical Institute of Canada (CIC).
- 3. PROCEDURE**
 - 3.1. Candidates should submit their applications before March 15th of the year of the award.
 - 3.2. All applications should be put in a sealed envelope and submitted to one of the three above departments to be forwarded to the Chair of the CIC Hamilton Section. The submission should consist of a 500 word summary of the research, an up to date CV, and a cover letter.
- 4. SELECTION COMMITTEE**
 - 4.1. The selection of a successful candidate shall be made by a committee consisting of the following three persons: The Chair of the CIC Hamilton Section who shall be the Committee Chair, plus one representative from each of the Chemical Technology programme at Mohawk College and either the Chemistry or the Chemical Engineering programmes at McMaster University, or another member of the CIC Hamilton Section Executive.
- 5. TERM OF THE REFERENCE FOR THE AWARD**
